On September 8, 2003, defendants filed a counterclaim

1 against plaintiffs in this matter. Doc # 4. On October 13,
2 2003, plaintiffs filed a motion to dismiss, to strike and for a
3 more definite statement with respect to that counterclaim. Docs
4 # 8. Defendants filed a motion to substitute attorney on
5 October 28, 2003. Doc # 12. On December 31, 2003, after the
6 case was ordered related and reassigned to the undersigned (Doc
7 # 10), plaintiffs refiled the motion to dismiss, to strike and
8 for a more definite statement. Doc # 15. Defendants filed a
9 stipulation of dismissal on January 23, 2004. Doc # 17.

10 Because defendants have filed a stipulation to dismiss,
11 plaintiffs' motions to dismiss, to strike and for a more
12 definite statement and defendants' motion to substitute attorney
13 are moot. Accordingly, the court TERMINATES those motions (Docs
14 ## 8, 12, 15) as an administrative matter.
